

The Mohegan Tribe Department of Athletic Regulation was assigned by the Association of Boxing Commissions to oversee an event that occurred on the Chickasaw Reservation. This observation was done prior to the acceptance into the Association of Boxing Commissions. Following is a synopsis of the event that occurred on June 24, 2011.

The event consisted of seven professional mixed martial arts fights. They started on time and in accordance with media and press releases pertaining to the event. All of the officials assigned to work the event, including the ring officials, inspectors and medical personnel reported at their respective times and ready to fulfill their duties delegated by the Chickasaw Nation Gaming Commission.

The event moved quickly and efficiently throughout its duration. The matchmaking was remarkable in relation to each match, which made for an eventful night. There was a fair ratio of knockouts to bouts going the full distance.

A final event report containing suspensions was completed by the Chickasaw Nation Gaming Commission and forwarded to the appropriate authorities, including the Association of Boxing Commissions Certified Mixed Martial Arts Registry.

From beginning to end, the event held by the Chickasaw Nation Gaming Commission was done in a professional manner (enclosed please find the forms that were utilized during the weigh-in and fight). Overall, the organization and logistics of running an event has been fully grasped by the Chickasaw Nation Gaming Commission.

It is the recommendation of the Mohegan Tribe Department of Athletic Regulation that the Chickasaw Nation Gaming Commission become active members of the Association of Boxing Commissions.
