

# **The Original Cutman Gel™**

All of us desire to aid the sports of Boxing as well as MMA. I have developed a safe, non-prescriptive and non-performance enhancing topical Cutman mixture that safely and effectively helps to speed the cessation of acute traumatic hemorrhage during athletic competition. The intent being that if a bleeding cut that poses no threat of permanent injury to the fighter can be quickly stopped, then the possibility for the well-trained athlete to compete to the bouts natural conclusion will be improved. A fight should not have to be stopped too soon because of bleeding to allow the true “sport” of boxing and MMA to come to fruition; “Perseverance over trial and adversity”.

The Cutman Gel is made from natural Chinese herbs. The topical application of which has no performance enhancing ability singularly or in combination. It is NOT intended to be taken internally. The mixture is compatible with standard currently approved topical cut treatments, i.e. Adrenaline 1:1000, Thrombin and Avitene, if desired. Each of these is also only intended as topical treatments, not systemic, for the cessation of bleeding wounds during competition. It can also be used as dry powder applied with a Q-Tip directly to the cut skin or mixed with water to make a gel. Other typical remedies such as a cold End Swell and direct pressure are always advisable. The mixture poses no additional risk of tissue scarring after it's use than currently approved tropicals. Standard of care wound cleansing and suture closure to a cut would be unchanged after the competitions conclusion as per standard medical advise.

**In Conclusion: I respectfully submit my formulation for approval as a topical, non-prescriptive, non-performance enhancing addition to the ABC Unified Rules for topical application to a fighter's face to stop bleeding during competition.**
