

## **SUSPENSIONS**

Just a reminder if you go to the home page of the MMA database and click on the "red" "complete list for all ACs" which is located on the line that says Fighters who fought while under suspension, you will see there are some contestants who have participated without clearance. As a reminder, before you approve a fighter, make sure they are not on suspension; if they are make the fighter provide the required medicals to the suspending commission to be released.

On your home page, if a promoter has submitted their fight card with the use of the database. There will be a list of all fighters who are currently on suspension that have been assigned to events.

Just one more way to make your job easier and to ensure that contestants who are on suspension do not participate

When you see a person on suspension that is scheduled to fight in your jurisdiction, please contact the suspension commission and have them removed before they participate.

Therefore, you can more easily monitor a fighter's removal from suspension.

The only way to see this feature is if the promoter submitted it through the database. Just click on the event and if anyone is on suspension, they will be listed.

.This update is now live, where any fighter whom is currently under an active suspension will have a note appended to their PUBLIC fight record on our site.

Mixedmartialarts.com and the MMA database committee are pleased to announce a change with the database. This new change will allow you to change only comments you made regarding a contestant. This will allow you to change any errors you made when entering data in the comments section and it will allow you to place temporary comments and "red flags" on contestants.

## **AUTHORIZATION**

Organizations that are authorized by a State or Tribal Commission will have access to the database on a READ ONLY Basis.

1. This means they MUST place the event online and pay the \$100 fee. This is important because it will designate if a fighter is scheduled for more than 1 event and the dates between events

2. They will have Access to ALL suspensions and whether there are medical requirements or not. Prior to this they were instructed to contact Commission
3. They CANNOT amend anything in the database
4. If any of these organizations enter the results they will be listed as NSF
5. Encourage these groups to use the current bout sheet to submit their results

### **MANDATORY NATIONAL ID**

1. SHOULD A FIGHTER HAVE TO SHOW NATIONAL ID CARD?
2. IF the answer is yes to #1 then as commissions we are responsible to make sure they get these ID Cards. There can still be issues with a fighter being issued the ID and; Not receiving it from a commission, fighter forgetting or losing it or just not having one.
3. Commissions who suspend fighters for not producing an National ID card have to be alert to quickly unsuspend them when one is produced or would it be easier for ALL of us to verify that the fighter does show they have a National ID from the database because the database will show their information as well as a photo and then consider placing a note in that fighter's record so that the next commission knows that they need to produce a National ID. If the database shows they have a National ID then possibly the next commission may make them get one from them and pay any fee to have that commission re-print the National ID card.
4. Fight results SHOULD have a National ID numbers with each fighter.
5. This will prevent issues with fighters with the same name having their records placed with another fighter's record
